

NDOT OVER DIMENSIONAL PERMITS INSTRUCTION 3-09

Date: January 5, 2009

Subject: Special Procedures and Conditions for Vehicles and Loads Exceeding Legal Width or Length

Reference: (a) NRS 484.737 – 484.767

(b) NAC 484.300 – 484.580

(c) Highway Agreement #NM 518-94-070 dated December 12, 1994

1. **Purpose.** To restrict or prohibit movement of all non-reducible vehicles and loads exceeding legal width limits (8 feet, 6 inches) or legal length limits (70 feet), and of all reducible, longer combination vehicles (LCVs) exceeding legal length limits (70 feet), on specific routes under the jurisdiction of the State of Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT).

2. **Background.** To protect both public and commercial traffic as well as Nevada's transportation infrastructure, specific routes are restricted or prohibited pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 484 and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 484, specifically references (a) and (b), The restrictions and prohibitions herein are updated as needed and are not all-inclusive. Additional permanent and temporary restrictions/prohibitions may be imposed due to other size or weight factors, maintenance, construction or acts of nature and will be advertised on the NDOT web site.

3. **Procedures and Conditions**

- a. These instructions and the restricted/prohibited routes indicated in the enclosure apply to all vehicles/loads requiring a permit issued by NDOT for over-sized vehicles/loads and by the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles, Motor Carrier Division (DMVMC) for LCVs in accordance with reference (c).
- b. Exceptions to these restriction/prohibitions will only be considered in extraordinary circumstances when there is no other reasonable routing alternative or when the point of origin, destination, pick-up or delivery is on the restricted route.
- c. Permittees may have to obtain additional permits from the agencies having jurisdiction over roadways not under the jurisdiction of NDOT.
- d. Possession of an annual permit of either type does not provide authorization to use any portion of the restricted/prohibited routes for any reason.

- e. Non-reducible vehicles/loads, including current annual permittees, that either exceed 8 feet, 6 inches in width or 70 feet in length, may obtain a separate single-trip permit to use any restricted/prohibited route for pick-up or delivery only. See enclosure for pilot car and law enforcement escort requirements.
- f. 4. **Action**

- a. Permittees are required to abide by these instructions unless otherwise advised by an authorized NDOT representative or permit agent. Permittees are advised to carry a copy of the applicable enclosure and any associated restriction lists/maps in their cab with their permit.
- b. Permit agents at NDOT and DMV will comply with this instruction, maintain a copy for daily reference, and make a copy of the enclosure with map available to all permittees.

5. **Supersedes.** NDOT Over Dimensional Permits Instruction 3-06 dated December 21, 2006. NDOT Over Dimensional Permits Instruction 4-06 dated December 21, 2006.

- **Reducible vehicles/loads and longer combination vehicles (LCV) exceeding legal length limits (70 feet) are strictly PROHIBITED** from using the below routes, including those with current permits issued by the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles, Motor Carrier Division (DMVMC).

- **Non-reducible vehicles/loads, exceeding legal width limits (8 feet, 6 inches) or legal length limits (70 feet) are RESTRICTED** on the below routes. These restrictions apply to all those with current over-sized permits issued by the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT). A single-trip permit may be obtained for the below routes, when there is no other reasonable routing alternative or when the point of origin, destination, pick-up or delivery is on the restricted/prohibited route. Non-reducible vehicles/loads exceeding 8 feet, 6 inches in width or 85 feet in length require pilot cars fore and aft. Additional pilot cars and law enforcement escorts may be required for vehicles/loads exceeding 12 feet in width or 85 feet in length at the discretion of NDOT and the Nevada Highway Patrol.
